The Regional Meetings and the Meeting of Ethnic Peoples are participation spaces designed to strengthen dialogue between the agrarian movement and the National Government around the Agrarian Reform agenda for the next decade. Throughout 2025, these gatherings will bring together peasants, Indigenous peoples, Black communities, Afro-descendants, Roma, Raizal and Palenquera peoples, as well as rural workers and the academic community, with the purpose of collectively building the Ten-Year Agrarian Reform Plan and defining Colombia's position for the Second International Conference on Agrarian Reform and Rural Development (ICARRD+20) in 2026
