

What Is the Ten-Year Agrarian Reform Plan?

It is a roadmap developed jointly by the agrarian movement and the National Government through five regional meetings and a gathering of ethnic peoples. This plan will guide the transformation of the Colombian countryside over the next 10 years (2026–2036).

Its actions will be guided by:

- The 12 fundamental pillars signed and agreed upon in the Pact for Land, Water, Territory, Environment, and Life.
- The implementation of the National Sectoral Plans of the Comprehensive Rural Reform, responding to the need to ensure fair, resilient, and sustainable agri-food systems, which are essential for building peace with social, economic, and environmental justice in Colombia.
- The coordinated intervention of all public institutions through the National System for Agrarian Reform and its 8 subsystems.

The programmatic lines of the Ministry of Agriculture, including:

1. Agrarian reform and land management
2. Agri-food and supply systems
3. Agricultural risk financing and management
4. Technical assistance and agro-industry programs
